## DATA DOWNLOAD

- Total hospitalizations 5,058 with 117 (2.3%) individuals experiencing homelessness. Current hospitalizations 104 with 2 (1.9%) individuals experiencing homelessness.
- We have had a total of 2,151 guests stay at our Q&I facilities. Total number of guests currently in our Q&I facility is 13.
