

HUD Withdraws CoC NOFO

- **December 8-FY 25 COC NOFO Update**

- The Department has withdrawn a Notice of Funding Opportunity (NOFO) with respect to the Continuum of Care (CoC) grant program. This withdrawal will allow the Department to make appropriate revisions to the NOFO, and the Department intends to do so. In the previous FY 24-25 NOFO, the Department reserved the right to make changes to the NOFO instead of processing renewals for a variety of reasons, including to accommodate a new CoC or Youth Homelessness Demonstration Program (YHDP) priority or new funding source. The Department still intends to exercise this discretion and make changes to the previously issued CoC NOFO to account for new priorities. HUD anticipates reissuing a modified NOFO well in advance of the deadline for obligation of available Fiscal Year 2025 funds.

HUD reissues CoC NOFO

- December 19-FY 25 CoC NOFO Update
- The Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) is issuing this Notice of Funding Opportunity (NOFO) for the 2025 Fiscal Year for public review. HUD understands this NOFO to be enjoined pursuant to a preliminary injunction entered in State of Washington, et al. v. HUD, No. 1:25-cv-00626-MSM-AEM (District of Rhode Island), and National Alliance to End Homelessness, et al. v. HUD, No. 1:25-cv-00636-MSM-AEM (District of Rhode Island). HUD will not implement or enforce this NOFO pending further court order. HUD will issue further clarification on the status of this or any other future Fiscal Year 2025 NOFO as necessary. HUD will provide further notice as to when the application portal will open.

HUD Outlines Process for Renewals

- HUD has outlined their steps to comply with the Court order in [this document](#).
- HUD indicates that by January 6 they will reopen the previous FY24-25 CoC NOFO to allow local communities to submit renewal applications.
- As HUD still reserves the right to issue/enact the new FY25 NOFO aligned with the current Administration's priorities, we are going to proceed with partner conversations around what we want to have projects ready to go whenever HUD solicits for new Transitional Housing and Supportive Services applications.

Impacts: Renewing FY24 grants

- Short term (1year) extension of support for Permanent Supportive Housing
 - Tenant-based rental assistance and case management supports
 - Approximately 400 households
 - Impacts would start in early calendar year 2027
- Coalition working with partners at State, City, County and providers to identify temporary funding to mitigate some impact
- Looking to develop applications for Transitional Housing and Supportive Services Only projects.
- HUD has made clear that they will be moving away from support for permanent housing toward temporary supports with service participation requirements.




HUD recent Policy Priorities

- Transitional housing
 - Short-term assistance
 - 40 hrs of required services per week /per client
 - Outcomes-exits to permanent housing (preferably unsubsidized) with employment income
- SSO-Standalone and Outreach
 - Required service engagement
 - Exits to housing
 - Exits with employment income





System Engagement




- 44% | 4,018 First time homeless in the system

- 38% | 3,476 Continuously homeless


Age of All Persons in Households





Household Composition
